*In the Peace of Christ*

*Dear Friends in Christ:*

*Of all the gifts that I have ever received, one which I cherish is my faith! I know that it sounds like a platitude for a priest to say that he cherishes his faith and ability to believe but that does not diminish the fact that I do see my faith as a beautiful and wonderful gift. Yet sometimes, maybe like you, I can take the beautifully rich and powerful gift of faith for granted. A few years ago, I met a gentleman who was intelligent, caring and sincere and who wanted to become Catholic. The problem causing him to hesitate was that he had a difficult time believing in the Eucharist. He knew and loved Jesus. He believed in God, but coming to accept in faith that the Eucharist was truly the body and blood of Christ and that Jesus was truly present in the Eucharist was a challenge and an obstacle to embracing Catholicism. For me, I couldn't fully understand the problem. Of course, Jesus was truly present in the Eucharist. Of course, the Holy Eucharist was the very body and blood of the Redeemer. Of course, the bread and the wine changed into Christ's body and blood at every Mass. What's the problem?*

*Well, of course, part of the problem is that we who have been given this faith, this beautiful and powerful gift, can forget that faith is a gift. We can forget how blessed we are to believe. We can take our faith for granted and fail to appreciate how exceptional and miraculous the gift of the Eucharist is and how blessed we are to know and believe that Jesus is present in the Holy Eucharist. Because it is so common and familiar to us we can forget how extraordinary the Eucharist is and how extraordinarily blessed we are to believe, much less receive this gift from heaven.*

*Familiarity can breed contempt or at least a laissez faire attitude. In an article I recently read the question was posed "Do you always genuflect when passing the Tabernacle or only when someone is watching?" Pretty damning stuff! Is our faith for show? How we reverence the Eucharist in private tells what we really believe. How we extend our reverence for Jesus from our heart and mind to our actions when no one is watching is a test for how we really believe. Likewise, how we treat the holy things of faith and how we treat the other gifts that we have been given by God tells us about ourselves. What are those gifts from God? Well, our lives, our bodies, our spouses, our families, our jobs, our homes, our opportunities, our talents – well, everything we have is a gift. They are not all equal but they are all gifts.*

*For us to appreciate the gift of faith and the gift of the Eucharist we must cherish the gift always. We believe in the Eucharist at home and at church, at work and at play, during the school year and on vacation. A help in appreciating the gift of faith is sharing this gift with others; be it a co-worker, a neighbor or the grandkids. An aid in keeping our faith healthy is always to treat the holy with reverence. Mass should never be just another thing on our "to do list". Every Mass is a gift. Every Communion is a gift of Jesus' love to us. Every Mass is special. I am always amazed at how people prepare to go to a movie or a play or a concert compared to how some prepare to come to Mass. How do you prepare? Or is our faith just for show? Gifts are to be enjoyed and shared. And the giver of the gift of faith, the gift of the Eucharist, is none other than God! Share the faith! Live the faith!*

## The Promises of the Sacred Heart Given to St. Margaret Mary by Jesus Christ

In the visions given to St. Margaret Mary regarding the devotion of the Sacred Heart, Jesus made many profound promises to the faithful.

St. Margaret Mary, 1647 – 1690, was a nun in France who received profound revelations from Jesus Christ to found a new devotion in the Catholic Church called the Devotion to the Sacred Heart. She was known for her profound humility and wisdom, much of which has been preserved to this day in such books as *The Autobiography of St. Margaret Mary* and *Thoughts and Sayings of St. Margaret Mary*.

### Four Great Apparitions

St. Margaret Mary experienced four great apparitions asking for the Devotion to the Sacred Heart to be founded and spread throughout the world. St. Margaret Mary summarized the 12 promises made by Jesus to her on behalf of all souls who would propagate, practice, further and pray this devotion in a letter to her spiritual director, Father Croiset and Father Rolin, on August 24th, 1685.

### Promises of Jesus for those who Practice Devotion to the Sacred Heart

1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.
2. I will give peace in their families.
3. I will console them in all their troubles.
4. They shall find in My Heart an assured refuge during life and especially at the hour of death.
5. I will pour abundant blessings on their undertakings.
6. Sinners shall find in My Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
7. Tepid souls shall become fervent.
8. Fervent souls shall speedily rise to great perfection.
9. I will bless the homes in which the image of My Sacred Heart shall be exposed and honoured.
10. I will give to priests the power to touch the most hardened hearts.
11. Those who propagate this devotion shall have their name written in My Heart, and it shall never be effaced.
12. The all-powerful love of My Heart will grant to all those who shall receive Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months the grace of final repentance; they shall not die under my displeasure, nor without receiving their Sacraments; My Heart shall be their assured refuge at that last hour.

St. Margaret Mary summed up her experiences in the same letter saying, “Oh, how sweet is death when one has had a tender devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus Christ!”

The Chaplet of the Divine Mercy is another Catholic Devotion with equally interesting origins and promises.

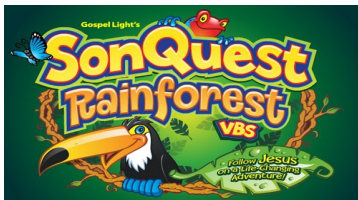
