In the Peace of Christ

Dear Friends in Christ:

You will notice in this week's bulletin that in the Stewardship Report for last week that the amount is "0". That is not because we forgot to take up a collection at the masses or that people did not give (we gave nearly \$50,000). Each year on the Feast of Corpus Christi, the Sunday collection for that day goes to the archdiocese for the support of St. Mary's Seminary. The seminary is indeed a treasure for us to have and a privilege for us to support. In addition to the educating and formation of priests, the seminary provides for the education and formation of deacons and laity in our archdiocese and throughout the state.

In the prayer of ordination for a priest, the bishop begs the Lord for additional co-workers in the Lord's vineyard, "*for we are weak and our need is greater.*" This is becoming truer by the day. Currently in our archdiocese we have three parishes in need of pastors and another four parishes where the pastor is serving beyond retirement age (75). We will ordain only two men to the priesthood this July. Indeed, *we are weak and our need is greater!* Here at SJV, we have three fabulous deacons, Dale, Al and Fred. Two of them (Dale and Fred) are officially in retired status though you would not know from all that they do around the parish. We have one candidate in Deacon Formation, Randy Graham. Happily, we have three young men accepted into the seminary for this coming year and another in the process of applying. Now, I do not want to be greedy, but that is not enough for a parish of 15,000 people. *We are weak and our need is greater.*

We need more young men to seriously pray and consider a vocation to the priesthood. All of us need to pray, work and invite young men to consider the priesthood as a way to live their lives for God. Some years ago, Archbishop Fiorenza asked that we try to offer a holy hour every week before the Blessed Sacrament to pray for more vocations. I echo and repeat his plea. But our need is not just for more priests; we also need deacons, religious sisters and brothers and lay ecclesial ministers. Why? Since the year 2000, we have closed nine parishes in the archdiocese. We have ordained 30 men to the priesthood but more than 80 priests serving in the archdiocese have died and 10 have resigned from the priesthood. All the while the number of Catholics has increased by nearly 250,000! *We are weak and our need is greater!*

Obviously changes must be made and are coming. Catholics are a resilient and faithful people, but let's be honest, sometimes we can be a hard headed, complaining and a selfish lot when we don't get our way. With the clergy shortage, we are not going to get our way. The clergy shortage is not theoretical. It is real and it is here right now, today! What is required of us is more faith, greater understanding, patience and sacrifice and more prayer. God has a plan for his Church and he will not leave us orphaned, but we have to do our part. So pray and beg God as ordaining bishops do, *for we are weak and our need is greater!*
