Objectives



The objectives of the choir are as follows:

- To worship the Lord in hymns, spiritual songs and psalms and to aid the congregation to worship in spirit through its singing.
- To afford an opportunity for Christian fellowship, for practical training in Christian service, and for healthy activities, both spiritual and physical, among members and friends.
- To encourage members to live consecrated lives in close communion with God and each other.
- To encourage members to live in service for the Lord both in word, songs, hymns, deed and conduct, as individuals and as a group.
- To support the Church in its policies and activities.
- To exalt the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ in its activities.

Policies/Guidelines

So we recognize the importance of music as a ministry, regular attendance is required at all rehearsals, masses and performances scheduled. A sincere commitment means that at least 80% attendance is necessary to maintain a well balanced and harmonious sound within the choir. In the event of an absence, the director must be notified in advance by email or phone, and a sign-out sheet will be provided for those days that your child cannot attend.

A calendar of scheduled events has been provided, and will be updated as needed to provide more opportunity as the children progress. All changes will be made via email no later than two weeks in advance. Please note that your commitment to the choir is part of your overall stewardship: the giving of time, talent, and treasure for the praise of our Lord Jesus Christ and for the glory of the kingdom of God.
