- 5 chair lifts (plus 2 conveyors)





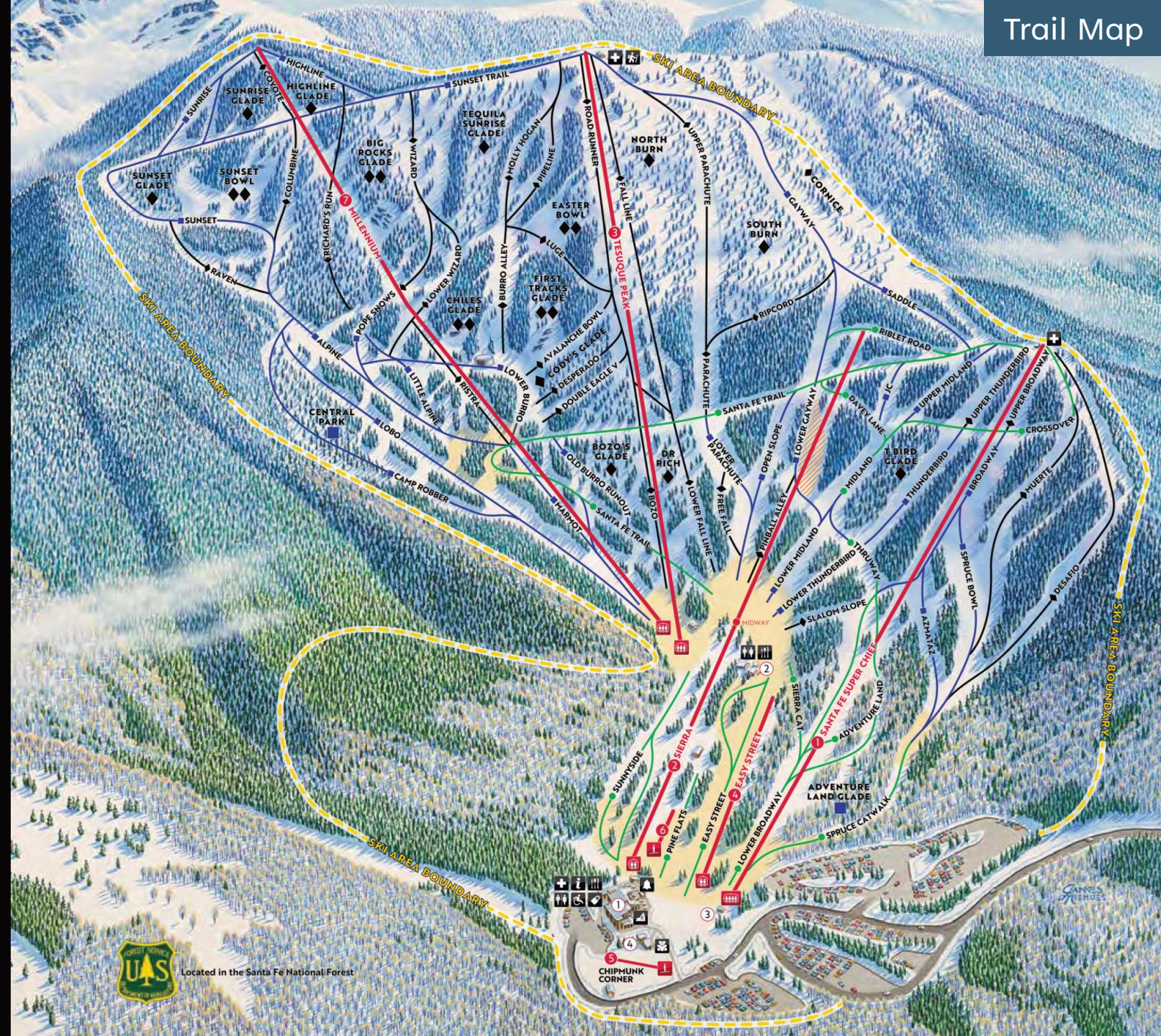

## What's Included?

- Hotel – 4 nights at double occupancy

# PRICING

## What about lessons?

The price will depend on whether you have ever skied before, as well as how many days you would want lessons.

It will cost around \$320 per day for someone who has never skied before, and around \$285 per day for someone who has. (Prices subject to any changes made by Ski Santa Fe)

## PAYMENT

- \$500 non-refundable deposit
- Can either pay in full or pay deposit and then split remaining balance into 2 payments of \$475
- All balances must be paid before December 2<sup>nd</sup> (no exceptions)

## WHAT TO BRING

- Ski Jacket
- Ski Pants
- Goggles/Eye Protection
- Gloves
- Ski socks/long socks
- Driver's License or School ID
- Cell Phone
- Lunch money (at least \$25/day recommended)
- Spending money



- Enough cold-weather clothes for 3-5 days
- Hoodies, jackets, sweaters
- Pants, jeans
- Long-sleeve shirts

# FAQ'S

Q: Is this a retreat?

A: No. this is a social trip, not a retreat. There will be prayer and a few other Catholic based activities.

Q: Can my child snowboard instead of skiing?

A: Yes! It is the same price for skiing or snowboarding. There will be an additional charge for both.

Q: What if my child doesn't want to ski or snowboard? Can they still go on the trip?

A: Unfortunately, they will not be able to go.

Q: Can my child bring their own skis?

A: Yes, however there will not be a discount.

Q: Will there be any free time?

A: Yes! There will be at least a couple hours of free time every day.

## FAQ'S CONTINUED

Q: How are rooms assigned? Are boys and girls together?

A: Teens will be able to select their roommates; however, we reserve the right to decide who is together. Boys and girls will room on different floors.

Q: Will there be other activities besides skiing?

A: Yes, we will likely have evening games and a private New Year's Eve party at the hotel ballroom. Unfortunately, snow tubing will not be possible.

Q: Are cell phones allowed?

A: Yes, during the day! In fact, we recommend bringing them for communications with chaperones. They will be turned in every night.

Q: What should we pack?

A: A packing list will be sent out before the trip. Make sure your teen has a ski jacket, ski pants, ski goggles, and gloves.
